

## STUDENT SUPPORT

Students with disability in the NT have a right to access a full and inclusive curriculum that meets individual needs.

The Department of Education provides services to all students in NT government schools, and provides assistance in some areas to non-government schools.

Children and young people can access support services including specialist education advisors, specialised equipment and resources.

The range of support services include:

- autism spectrum
- counselling
- disability
- early childhood intervention


- hearing

Student Support provides consultative and collaborative support services to all schools in the Northern Territory. Regional teams of education advisors are committed to providing effective specialist services to support schools and other service providers to improve educational outcomes for children referred.

## Whole school approach to improving student achievement

Student Support personnel provide services across disability and mental health through a model consistent with the *Response to Intervention* approach.

The model integrates assessment and learning processes into a whole school approach to improve student learning and behaviour outcomes.



**Level 1:** High quality teaching and learning processes engage students so that they achieve academic, social and emotional outcomes.

**Level 2:** Specific interventions target the learning and behavioural challenges of students requiring support.

**Level 3:** Implemented individualised supports for students requiring intensive support to achieve educational, social and emotional outcomes.
