Anglicare NT

At Stuart Lodge there is short to medium term transitional accommodation, case management and support services for residents who are experiencing difficulty in accessing accommodation and who are at risk of homelessness.

The on-site Homelessness Hub at Stuart Lodge is there to assist clients to avert homelessness through referrals for appropriate accommodation and support services.

Subsidised Private Rental Program

This program includes client case management and mentoring support. In conjunction with the Mental Health Association of Central Australia and the Alice Springs Women's Shelter. Primarily targeted to people who have a mental illness and women and children experiencing domestic/family violence.

Private Rental Liaison Program

This program targets individuals and families experiencing difficulty in accessing housing in the private rental market although they have the financial means to do so.
