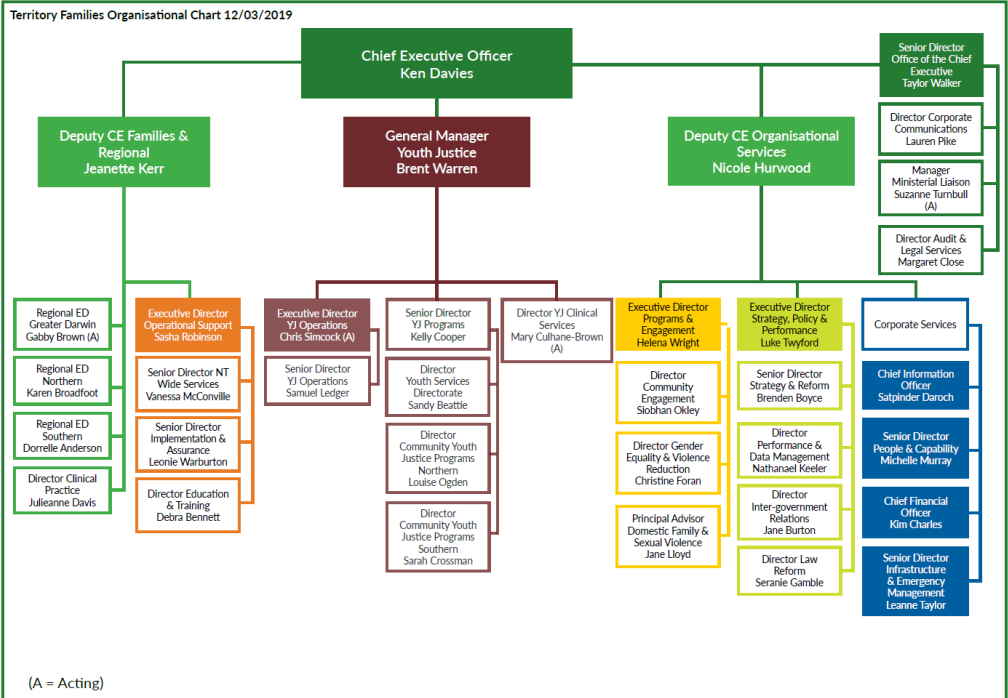
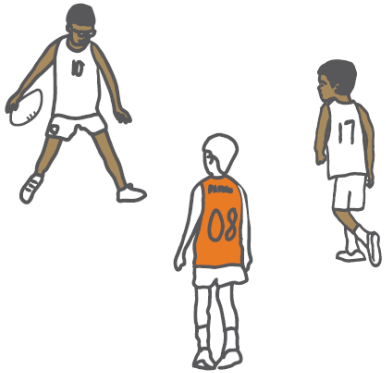

The Southern Region operates a 'catchment' approach to case allocation meaning workers are designated to communities, enabling relationships and knowledge to grow, and the efficiency of casework to be maximised (i.e. staff could conduct work on multiple cases per travel event).

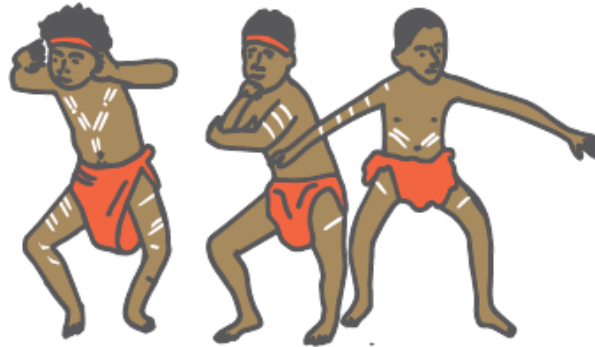

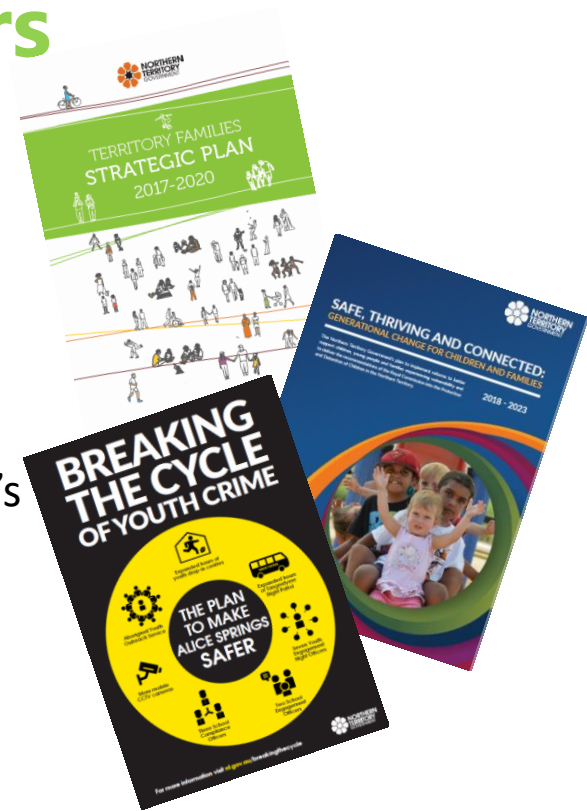

- Breaking the Cycle (the Northern Territory Government's response to community concerns for youth crime and anti-social behaviour in Alice Springs).

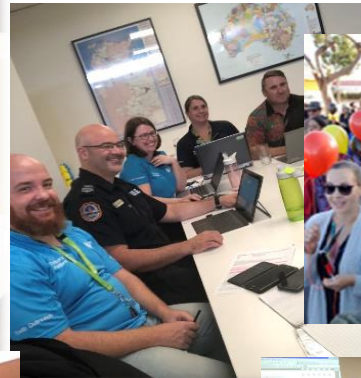


Southern Region; Looking Forward

- Increase the number of children living with their families
- Increase and improve family-led decision making
